Day One–Tuesday 8th July

You will depart early in the morning and travel by road to Accra. You will be responsible for clearing immigration and customs at the "Seme" border between Nigeria and Republic of Benin, the village of "Houtounji" between the Republic of Benin and Togo, and the city of "Aflao" at the Togo-Ghana border. You will be responsible for all the expenses of crossing the border going to and from Accra. The total anticipated round trip cost of crossing the borders is 2,000 Naira.

After arrival in Accra, you will check in at the Sankofa Beach House (see www.sankofamerotours.com) or accommodations close by depending on availability.

Day Two–Wednesday 9^h July

After a late breakfast, you are free to relax from the long road journey and walk along the beach, swim in the ocean, play volley ball or read a book or travel to town to take a tour of the University of Ghana, Legon.

Later in the day you will travel to Sankofa Beach House to register for the Pan African Student Summit. Following the "Welcome Dinner" you will participate in the Summit Orientation "Finding Common Ground."

Following the tour of the Nkrumah Memorial, you will have an introduction to shopping at the Arts Center Bazaar in the Center for National Culture. You can buy gifts like the popular "Kente cloth, fabrics, carvings, leather goods and jewelry, as well as a host of other souvenir items.

Day Six-Sunday 13th July

You will depart for Lagos early in the morning with an early evening arrival in Lagos.

Aburi Gardens/Boti Falls

The tour begins at 7:30 am with departure from the lobby of your hotel. You will arrive at Boti Falls at approximately 9:00 am. The tour proceeds on to Aburi Botanical Gardens where you will tour the gardens. You will take your lunch in the Garden's restaurant. After lunch, there will be an opportunity to purchase wood carvings from the Aburi wood carvers along the return road. The expected time of return to the hotel is 16:00.

Boti Falls

This spectacular waterfall is situated in the Eastern Region of Ghana, embedded at the heart of the forest reserve at Huhunya, which is about 17km North-East of Koforidua, the regional capital. It is seasonal with cascades in the immediate surrounding areas. It is fed by the River Pawnpawn and is best enjoyed between June - August, during the rainy season. In the immediate vicinity of the falls are caves, cascades, and an "umbrella" rock worth exploring.



Aburi Botanical Gardens

The Aburi Botanical Gardens is one of the most beautiful, peaceful and fascinating places in Ghana. Opened in March, 1890, and covering 64.8 hectares and overlooking the Accra coastal plain from an elevation of 370 to 460 meters above sea level, the Aburi Botanical Gardens is a must experience for every Ghanaian as well as visitors to Ghana. Situated in the town of Aburi, which is well-known for its healthy climate, the gardens also

have pleasant indoor-outdoor restaurants and facilities for staying overnight.
